If you have a student that is planning on attending college next year please register now for your FSA ID at fafsa.ed.gov. You will need a pin number before you can begin your FAFSA Financial Aid application. All students should apply for FAFSA even if you will not need to borrow money to attend school. A student must have a filed FAFSA before a school can offer them a scholarship. You can apply for the FSA ID now. The FAFSA application opens October 1.

WATER QUALITY ANNOUNCEMENT FROM PGCPs:

Dear Prince George's County Public Schools Community,

In our continued effort to maintain safe drinking water for our students and staff, Prince George's County Public Schools (PGCPS) began comprehensive testing in April of drinking water sources in our facilities. These sources include water fountains and sinks in health rooms, teachers' lounges and kitchens.

PGCPS Building Supervisors recently began placing "non-potable water" labels above specific fixtures:

- **Valved-off drinking water sources** that previously tested above U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) action levels
- **Non-drinking water sources**, such as sinks in classrooms, bathrooms, custodial closets and work areas

Non-potable water can be used for non-drinking and non-cooking purposes, such as washing

your hands. A sample sign is attached.

To date, we have tested more than 1,700 fixtures in approximately 90 schools. Testing on the remaining schools is expected to conclude by January 2018. Updates on our Water Quality Program can be found at www.pgcps.org/water-quality-program and on school webpages. A list of Frequently Asked Questions is attached.

Safe drinking water in our schools remains our highest priority. Thank you for your continued support.
