Q. Who is the new principal?

A. Dr. Patricia Payne

Q. What are the school's hours?

A. 9:00 a.m. - 3:40 p.m.

Q. Will there be an orientation prior to school opening?

A. Orientation(s) will be held the 3rd week of August 2009 - Dates and time will be posted in a forthcoming newsletter.

Q. Will there be a mandatory uniform policy?

A. No. Benjamin Foulois will not be a uniform school for the 2009-2010 School year. Uniforms may be revisited at the end of the year.

Q. If I have been accepted via audition, when may I register?

Q. Will there be 8th grade the first year of opening?

A. No. Benjamin Foulois will open as a K-7 School and grow into 8th grade the following year. PGCPS is not able operate a full academic grade with less than 20 students.

Q. How many students will be enrolled?

A. There will be 425 students for the 2009-10 school year.

Q. Will the school have a fully-integrated arts program?

A. Yes

Q. Will the school hold student performances the first year?

A. Yes.

Construction Update



Crews are diligently working on the second phase of construction which includes: the first floor classroom wing, the Media Center rooms, and the new Science rooms, Science Prep rooms, ESOL Classroom, Special Education classroom, Kindergarten classrooms, Primary classrooms, and an assistant principal's office.
