University of Maryland School of Nursing Physicals



Family nurse practitioners and students from the University of Maryland School of Nursing will provide free school and sports physicals for children ages 2-18 who do not have insurance or a regular primary care provider. **Physicals will be given by appointment only** from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. November 3, 4, 10, 11, 17, and 18 in the Cool Spring Elementary School parking lot (8910 Riggs Rd., Adelphi, MD 20783). Parents are asked to bring the child's immunization records and insurance (including medical assistance) cards with them to the appointment.

Depending on the age of the child and school requirements, parents may need to schedule and pay for required lab tests and/or follow up for necessary vaccinations at the health department. Examinations will be provided for children with special needs such as heart problems, joint problems, and other pre-existing conditions. The nurse practitioner may recommend follow up with a more specialized provider in order to complete the physical.
