You can . . .

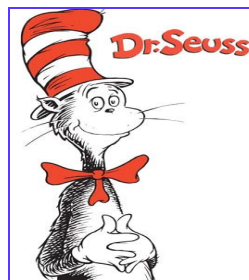
- ✓ Have a job or be unemployed
