- how I feel about what happened
- what I liked about a character/ what I didn't like
- what I learned about a character (character traits)
- favorite parts
- what I would change about the book, or the part I just read
- what I thought about how the author wrote this part/the description
- pictures I made in my mind when I read a part
- what I predict will happen next/what the sequel to this book would be about
- how the characters feel in this part
- how the author might have used nonfiction (real life) to write fiction
- why something happened in the story (cause and effect)
- what made this part exciting/sad/funny, etc.
- how I liked an illustration/ how I would have done it differently
- how I'm like or different from a character (compare/contrast)
- questions I have about this part
- this part reminds me of... (in my life-text to self, in another book- text to text)
- identify a lesson/theme/moral of the story or part I read
- make inferences/draw conclusions
- summarize/paraphrase the text
- make text to world connections
