

Eagle Time: Privileges and Remediation Program

What is a privilege and remediation period?

A privilege and remediation period (Eagle Time at High Point) is designed to provide students with remediation during the school day. Students will have an assigned place to be during a 30-minute period that will occur every day. They will be in a teacher's classroom, the cafeteria, or the library.

How does Eagle Time Work?

Remediation

Before First Quarter Progress Reports

Students remain with their First Period teacher for the entire Eagle Time period. (Note: The time should not be used to teach content. This is a period for remediation, completing homework, reading for pleasure, or studying.)

Freshmen will attend seminars on Tuesday and Thursdays (conducted by counselors and administrators.)

Progress Reports to First Quarter

Any student with at least one printed "E" is mandated to meet with his/her teacher during Eagle Time. The student must attend the remediation session for the class in which he/she has an "E" until the end of that grading cycle. If the student raises his grade above "E" before the end of the grading cycle, he/she still has to stay in the remediation session until the end of the grading cycle.

After First Quarter Grades

Any student with at least one "D" or "E" is mandated to meet with his/her teacher during Eagle Time. The student must attend the remediation session for the class in which he/she has a "D" or an "E" until the end of that grading cycle. If the student raises his grade above a "D" or an "E" before the end of the grading cycle, he/she still has to stay in the remediation session until the end of the grading cycle.

If a teacher feels a student who does not have a "D" or an "E" needs extra help or has work to complete, the teacher can mandate that the student attend remediation during Eagle Time.

Students must remain in one location for the entire 40-minute Eagle Time period. Passes to another teacher or location are not permitted.

Eagle Time Privilege

Students who are not assigned to Eagle Time remediation with a teacher will be rewarded with an Eagle Time privilege. Students will be allowed to go to the cafeteria, library, or to any teacher of their choosing.

What are the consequences for not attending remediation?

First Unexcused Remediation Absence	One Week of Lunch Detention in SSC Teacher and AP contact parents.
Second Unexcused Remediation Absence	After-School Detention Teacher and AP contact parents.
Third Unexcused Remediation Absence	All-Day in-School Suspension (SSC) Teacher and AP contact parents.
Fourth and Subsequent	Suspension AP contacts parents.
