RE: Exclusion Date for New Immunization Requirements

New school immunization requirements passed through Maryland legislation last year (COMAR 10.06.04.03 E (2)) went into effect January 2007. The regulation states that students in grades 5-9 who fail to meet state immunization requirements can be excluded from school. This is a reminder that proof of the new immunization requirements for Varicella (chicken pox), and Hepatitis B or proof of immunity or doctor's documentation of chicken pox disease with the month and year of infection is required.

All affected students must be in compliance by January 2, 2007 or have an appointment for their immunization to be administered on or before January 20, 2007. Currently, your child is out of compliance effective January 2, 2007. Your child has been excluded from school effective January 3, 2007.

Please contact your child's doctor to ensure that your child meets these requirements. Please do not send your child to school on January 3, 2007 unless all requirements have been met.
