

Buck Lodge Middle school Mandatory Uniform Policy 2009-2010

Uniform dress is required to be worn by all students. Students should practice good hygiene and take pride in their appearance. If a student is out of uniform, he/she will be sent to in-school suspension. Persistent violations to the dress code will result in disciplinary action and/or transfer to another school. The school uniform program will accommodate students' religious expression.

<u>TOPS</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 7th grade – solid white, correct fit • 8th grade – solid golden yellow, correct fit • All tops must have school logo • Long or short sleeved, collared, polo- style shirt with two or three buttons at the neck • Tops must be tucked in securely so that the belt is shown all the way around 	<u>TOPS</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May not have any colored piping, embroidery, designs, other logos, characters, names or numbers (No oversized or 1X-3X) • Sleeveless tops, fish net, crop tops, v-necks, halter tops, colored undershirts, and other T- shirts which can be seen through the uniform shirt are not allowed
<u>SWEATERS</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cotton, poly-cotton, waist length sweater, either black or white with school uniform logo, correct fit • All sweaters must be worn over the uniform shirt with the collar out 	<u>SWEATERS</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May not fall past the waist • Tops may not have a hood, zipper, designs, logos, characters, names or numbers of any type • Jacket and coats may not be worn in class and must be kept in your locker
<u>BELTS</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One color – black , leather, leather-like, or braided belt must go through the loops and buckled securely at the waist, belt buckles should be gold, silver toned or plain leather without showing any characters or names 	<u>BELTS</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Belts may not contain stripes, additional colors, designer logos, characters, bottle caps, rhinestones, plastic, gel, eyelets, names, drug pictures, skeleton heads or numbers of any size
<u>SHOES</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SOLID BLACK SNEAKERS ONLY • Stripe or logo must be black • Shoelaces must be solid black • Must fully cover or enclose the foot • Boots may be worn during inclement weather and changed upon arrival at school. 	<u>SHOES</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shoes may not contain colored stripes or designer logos, additional colors, characters, names or numbers of any size • Winter boots or snow boots must be changed if worn • No boots to be worn in the building • No sandals, open shoes
<u>PANTS</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Khaki colored pants only • The cuffs of the pants should touch the tops of your black sneakers • Uniform pants are to be worn securely around the waist with a belt securely through loops 	<u>PANTS</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No stretch pants • No "skinny pants" • No capri pants • No shorts • May not fall below the waist, be baggy or sag, and may not contain designer logos, characters, names or numbers of any size • Rubber bands and bandanas are not allowed on any part of your pants; pants may not be rolled up or tucked into shoes or boots
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Skirts will be determined on a case by case basis in order to accommodate religious expression 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Skirts will be determined on a case by case basis in order to accommodate religious expression
<u>SOCKS</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Black or white • Ankle length or above • All black or white hosiery 	<u>SOCKS</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be absent of characters, multi-color print, designs, cutouts, holes, characters, names, anything dangling or logos • No stockings
<u>JEWELRY & ACCESSORIES</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One necklace, must be tasteful and worn inside the shirt • Earrings (small gold or silver studs or hoops) • One pocket book • One watch (alarm sounds not allowed during school hours) 	<u>JEWELRY & ACCESSORIES</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No necklaces with religious meaning, no bracelets • Authorized jewelry items may not be replicas of weapons, contraband, nor contain inappropriate language, no colored or big earrings • No oversized necklaces or earrings • No backpack style pocketbooks allowed
<u>HAIR ACCESSORIES</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Barrettes, headbands, scrunches/pony tail holders are acceptable 	<u>HAIR ACCESSORIES</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No bandanas, hats, scarves, do-rags, big ribbons, skull caps, or baseball caps
