Dear Parents/Guardians of Ernest Everett Just Students,

All students are required to wear the mandatory uniform as described below. The approved vendor for Ernest Everett Just Middle School for purchasing uniforms with the school logo will be All American Wear, 5001-B Forbes Blvd. Lanham, Maryland, 20706.

Parents who have already purchased polo shirts with the EEJMS logo may allow their student to wear those items to school. It is **NOT REQUIRED THAT SHIRTS HAVE LOGOS**. All students clothing must be worn to size and must fit correctly. They cannot sag, be baggy or tight. The items must be worn at the natural waistline as stated in the PGCPs Dress Code Policy. The official school uniform is as follows:

Mandatory Items:

Pants: (Cargo pants are NOT allowed)

7th grade – Khaki

8th grade – Khaki

Skirts: (All skirts must be knee length or no shorter than fingertips. Skorts that have the appearance of a skirt in the back and front may be worn)

7th grade – Khaki

8th grade – Khaki

Shirts: (All students must wear solid color long or short sleeved **polo style** shirts according to grade)

7th grade – Light Blue

8th grade – Navy Blue

Belts: Black or Brown (No designer belts or buckles of any kind will be allowed)

Shoes: All students must wear shoes that are closed at the toe and heel. (No **crocs** or sandals allowed.)

Optional Additions:

Vests: Students may wear a V-neck vest in solid Navy, Khaki, White or Black.

Sweaters: Students may wear solid Navy, Khaki, White, or Black- No Hoods.

Fleece Pull-Overs: Students may wear solid Navy, Khaki, White or Black.

Head Coverings: As stated in the PGCPs Dress Code “Headdress may be worn indoors for religious or health reasons only.” Parents/Guardians must formally make requests, in writing to the Principal.

Jewelry & Accessories: Jewelry should not pose safety hazard (i.e. no spiked jewelry, chokers, and oversized chains). Authorized jewelry items may not be replicas of weapons or contraband nor contain inappropriate language. No oversized necklaces, lanyard or earrings larger than the diameter of a quarter.

Violations of the Dress Code will result in the following:

1. First Offense- phone call and/or letter home.
2. Second Offense- In School Suspension (1 day)
3. Third Offense-In School Suspension (2 or more days)

We at Ernest Everett Just Middle School look forward to a great school year. This uniform policy is one step toward keeping Ernest Everett Just Middle School a safe and orderly place for your children to obtain their education.
