Student Performance Information for Role Model Performances

1. Students will select a role model to represent in a performance.
2. Students will provide a picture of their role model.
3. Students will perform in front of an audience, representing their chosen role model.

Criteria for students representing their role model:

1. Your role model must exhibit positive character.
2. You must be prepared to dress up like your role model and wear appropriate attire.
3. You must interview your role model and be prepared to recite your memorized bibliography.
4. You must invite your role model to the performance, if available.

Questions to ask the role model you are interviewing:

1. What is your name?
2. When were you born?
3. Where were you born?
4. What schools have you attended?
5. What accomplishments have you made in your life?
6. What awards have you received?
7. What was your dream or ideal career goal?
8. What career are you currently working?
9. What advice can you give to students?
