Eligibility Requirements

All students in grades 6, 7, and 8 must earn an overall quarter GPA of at least 2.0 in order to participate in interscholastic athletics. The prior quarter grades only are used to determine eligibility.

Only students in grades 6, 7 and 8 may participate in interscholastic athletics in middle schools.

Students are required to have an annual medical evaluation before participation. Medical evaluations are valid for one calendar year. Prince George's County Public Schools Medical Evaluation Forms must be used (PGIN #7540-3100). A licensed physician, certified physicians' assistant under the supervision of a licensed physician or certified nurse practitioner, shall perform the examination.

Rising 6 grade students are eligible for fall sports only.
